Moira de Roche is an independent consultant. She is the Chair of IFIP (International Federation for Information Processing) [IP3](#), and a member of the IFIP board. Moira was awarded the IFIP Silver Core in 2016.

Moira worked on the IFIP Ethics Task & Finish Group. This team, using the ACM Code of Ethics as a starting point, drafted a Code that is suitable for use by any IFIP member society, or organization wishing to embed an ethical culture. The code has been published electronically and will come out in book form in September 2021.

Moira is an accomplished speaker and has presented at conferences around the world and in South Africa, on diverse subjects including Technology & Learning, IT Leadership, Professionalism, Trust & the Duty of Care in Digital, as well as people-related issues with Industry 4.0. She is often quoted in the South African press in articles on Education and Learning.

She has attended and presented at the World Summit for Information Society since 2012 and has been Head of Mission for IFIP at WSIS for 2019, 2020 and 2021.

A Past-President of IITPSA (Institute of IT Professionals South Africa) Moira is a Professional Member and Fellow and serves as a Non-executive Director. She received the IITPSA Distinguished Service in ICT Award in 2009. She is currently chair of the IITPSA Social and Ethics committee.

Moira is a Councillor for the South African National Museum, which is in Bloemfontein, South Africa. She also serves on the board committee: IT, Marketing & Core Business, and the Artbank Acquisitions Committee.

She is a member of ACM and the South African Institute of Directors.
